> Brief report on major events

As a part of "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav" celebrations, MPEDA NETFISH Kolkata in association with Narayanitala Dhaneswar Siksha Sadan, Freserganj, Indian Coast Guard, Freserganj Grampanchayet, Coastal P.S, Freserganj, Fisherman Associations, Secretary of Dakshin Banga Matsyajibi Forum, Kakdwip and Kulpi division had organized Coastal Clean-up Programme commemorating International Coastal Clean-up Day on 27th August 2022 at Bakkhali Sea Beach, Freserganj. The theme of the programme was "Swachh Sagar, Surakshit Sagar". The auspicious programme was started with "National Anthem" and head master of Narayanitala Dhaneswar Siksha Sadan was inaugurated the programme and highlighted on the significances of observing the day and impact of marine litters in our environment. Shri Atanu Ray, State Coordinator delivered a talk on various activities of NETFISH and MPEDA, significances of celebrating International Coastal Clean-up Day, impact of plastics on our environment specially in the marine life etc. Indian Coast Guard official narrated on the purpose of the programme, abuse of plastic wastes etc. Representatives of different fisherman association highlighted on the cleanliness, hygiene & sanitation as well as clean the sea beach and conserve the resources etc. Shri Darshan Lal Dhondiyal, Asst.
