- Conducted **2 nos. of Value added Fishery Product training programme** for SC Fishers at Vaikom region, Kerala under MPEDA SC/ST scheme.

- Conducted **15 No. of CIFT sponsored Harbour based training programme** for SC fishers at Freserganj, West Bengal & Odisha.
- Conducted **3 nos. of CIFT Sponsored Value added fishery product training** programme for SC fishers at Dakshin Kannada Dist., Karnataka.

As part of MPEDA sponsored awareness programme for SC fishers, NETFISH Odisha had organized “One week at a harbor programme” during 20th to 24th June 2022 at Mirzapur, Chilka. The five day long programme started with the registration of fishers followed by awareness classes on various topics such as Fish quality management, Hygiene and sanitation, Different type of crafts and gears, Fishery products, Export variety fishery products available in Chilka area, HACCP, Fishermen co-operative societies, OMFRA, Marine resources and its conservation, Sea Safety & Navigation, etc. Group discussions were also conducted in between these awareness programmes. Hands on training programme on fishery product preparation and Cleaning and sanitation were also done during the programme. A field trip to the seafood processing unit was also arranged for the fishers in which they observed various facilities & activities in the unit like Preprocessing, processing, freezing, cold storage, etc. On the last day an evaluation was also conducted for the fishers and NETFISH distributed certificates to all the participants.
