State Level Workshop on Implementation of TED: MPEDA-NETFISH in association RD MPEDA Vizag, Dept. of fisheries Andhra Pradesh & ICAR-CIFT had conducted a state level workshop on Implementation of TED in Trawl gears of Andhra Pradesh on 14<sup>th</sup> August 2024. The workshop began with a welcome address by Shri. R.Prasad Naik, Asst. Director, RD MPEDA, Visakhapattinam. Shri. K. Karunakar Rao, District Fishery Officer of Kakinada inaugurated the function by lighting the lamp. The event was commenced with introductory remarks by Dr. Joice V Thomas, CE MPEDA-NETFISH. Shri. A. Jayabal, JD, MPEDA, highlighted the impact of the US ban on sea-caught shrimp and the need of strict implementation of TED in Indian trawlers. Shri. P. Hanumantha Rao, State Coordinator NETFISH, delivered an insightful presentation in regional language on the design and specifications of TED in accordance with NOAA guidelines. CIFT designed TED was also demonstrated to the participants. Around 75 stakeholders including officials from ICAR-CIFT, ICAR-CMFRI, FSI, Forest Dept., SEAI, Boat operators association, etc. were participated in the workshop. Dr. M.Murali Mohan, State Coordinator AP South region, Vijayawada delivered the vote of thanks.
