- Conducted 29 nos. of SC fisher welfare programs & 2 nos. of ST Fisher welfare program in various regions utilizing the SC/ST funds with NETFISH
- Conducted 46 nos. of awareness programs on TED in various regions.
- Conducted 4 Nos. of On board demonstration program for TED in Odisha.
- Conducted 7 nos. of Sea food unit training program in various regions and an income of Rs.70,000/- is generated for NETFISH as training fee.
- 267 nos. of awareness classes on Hygiene & Conservation were organized through the Harbour Data Collectors at respective harbours.
- Carried out 133 nos. of by-catch surveys under the marine mammal project. Under the Marine Observer program obtained data of 8 sightings which involve 5 bottlenose dolphin, 2 Irrawaddy dolphin and a Pantropical spotted dolphin and 7 interactions of Olive ridley's.
